Alex's case manager will continue to monitor, evaluate, and coordinate with informal and formal supports and with Alex to ensure all of his health and safety needs are being met so he can attend PAI, his day program- once it's back open, continue living in his current home, work on his communication skills so he can get his needs and wants met and stay healthy.

What will others do?

Alex's FAMILY will provide informal supports to ensure Alex's health and safety needs are met, as well as help him build and maintain all skills so he can attend PAI, his day program-once it's back open, continue living in his current home, work on his communication skills so he can get his needs and wants met and stay healthy.

Libby Johnson Jeldes and Miguel Jeldes, Alex's GUARDIANS will continue to exercise their powers and responsibilities, unless stated differently in the guardianship order, of: establishing place of abode (residential); care, comfort and maintenance needs; personal property; medical care; contracts; exercise supervisory authority; and assure eligibility for government benefits; They will complete their annual filing responsibilities as mandated by the court. They will work with Alex to build and maintain all skills so he can attend PAI, his day program-once it's back open, continue living in his current home, work on his communication skills so he can get his needs and wants met and stay healthy, and ensure all his health and safety needs are met.

Libby Johnson Jeldes and Miguel Jeldes, Alex's REPRESENTATIVE PAYEE will continue to assist with money management; assist with completion of all documents to maintain eligibility for state and federal benefit programs.

What will the provider do?

PAI, Alex's RESIDENTIAL services provider will continue to work with Alex to build and maintain all skills so he can attend PAI, his day program-once it's back open, continue living in his current home, work on his communication skills so he can get his needs and wants met and stay healthy, and to ensure all his health and safety needs are met.

PAI, Alex's VOCATIONAL services provider will continue to offer Alex life enrichment services at his adult day program work on his communication skills so he can get his needs and wants met and remain healthy, and to ensure his health and safety needs are met during their scheduled time.

RISKS

How will Health and Safety Issues be Addressed?

Alex lacks self-preservation and safety skills. He is not able to identify, call 911 or seek assistance during emergencies. Due to Alex's mobility and cognitive delay, Alex needs assistance to safely evacuate during emergencies or drills. Alex is not able to indicate if he is ill or injured. He will yell if he is uncomfortable. His caregivers observe him for changes in his behavior and appearance for signs of illness or injury.

Alex needs constant supervision while at home and while in the community. Alex lacks kitchen safety skills. He needs someone with him in the community to help him maneuver his wheelchair and to help identify him and keep him safe.

Alex is not able to identify or keep himself safe from any forms of abuse. He may make noises that could provoke others from abusing him. He is vulnerable to financial exploitation. He is not able to make reports of abuse and relies on his guardians and caregivers to make reports on his behalf. He also relies on his team to observe him for changes in his appearance and behaviors of any signs of abuse.

Phoenix Residence (PRI) provides 24-hour plan of care with overnight awake supervision for Alex. PAI (Phoenix Alternatives, INC) and Alex's guardians provide a 24-hour plan of care. This is the appropriate level of supervision for Alex.

Alex needs a guardian, rep payee, and support services staff to help ensure his basic needs are met.

His parents, Elizabeth (Libby) Johnson Jeldes and Miguel Jeldes, act as his court appointed guardians and help him make legal decisions.

His parents, Libby Johnson Jeldes and Miguel Jeldes, act as his rep payee and work with Phoenix Residence to complete all paperwork for his government benefits.

Alex's guardians and Phoenix Residence work together to ensure Alex's basic needs are met, i.e. food, shelter, and clothing.

He has an IDD case manager that works with the team to ensure his services needs are being met by providers.

His team works together to protect Alex as a vulnerable adult.
