**Summary of Service Outcome and Support Progress**

**Outcome # 1**

**Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement:** Mark will independently read a social story about eating slowly before lunch with one or less prompts, 60% of all trials until next review.

**Summary of progress toward achieving this outcome:** Mark achieved this outcome 48/53 trials or 91% of trials.

**Recommendation for implementing this outcome:**  Continue     Change     Discontinue

**Rationale for the recommendation:** Mark has achieved this outcome as written but has only been working on it again since his return to PAI in January after almost a year off. Mark will continue this outcome with the percentage increased to 80% until at least his semi annual time.

**Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement:** Mark will pick and participate in one community activity, different than where he went the previous month, until next review.

**Summary of progress toward achieving this outcome:** No data.

**Description of the person's status**

**Health:** Mark has been in good health this review period. Mark did experience a seizure at PAI on 1/11/2021 and 911 was called. Mark has since been to the doctor, started a seizure medication at home, and has a seizure protocol.

**What is currently important to the person and for the person:** The important to Mark items are: living with his parents, working, and staying busy. The important for Mark items are: staying safe and maintaining good health by remembering to eat slowly and staying active in his community.

**Status of social relationships and natural supports:** Mark has had consistent social supports at PAI during this review period at home and at PAI. Mark has enjoyed more and more of his peers and staff returning to PAI over the last few months.

**Recent inclusion and participation in the community:** Community outings are currently on hold at PAI due to ongoing covid-19 health and safety concerns.

**New or ongoing opportunities for the development and exercise of functional and age-appropriate skills, decision making and choice, personal advocacy, and communication:** Mark chooses how many classes he would like to take at PAI and which classes. Mark is involved in making decisions that impact him. Mark chooses where he would like to do on community outings.
