This outcome also encourages Jerome to make an independent choice based off his personal preferences, it encourages Jerome to reach to get his chosen bottle, and it encourages Jerome to use his fine motor skills.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>“Daily, Jerome will choose a bottle for the day when he arrives in 80% off trials over the next six months.”</b></p>	
<p><b>Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome:</b>            This outcome will be trialed daily when Jerome arrives to PAI in the morning.</p> <p>When Jerome arrives in the morning and gets settled in, staff will bring his bucket of bottles to him. They will inform him that it is time to choose his bottle for the day. Staff will set them up for Jerome to see all of his options. If Jerome chooses a bottle, this outcome will be documented as “Y” for achieved. If Jerome does not choose a bottle, staff will ask him again roughly 15 minutes later. If Jerome chooses a bottle, this outcome will be documented as “Y” for achieved. If Jerome does not choose a bottle this time, this outcome will be documented as “N” for not achieved.</p> <p>Staff will honor Jerome’s choices and communication.</p>	
<p><b>Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments:</b>            N/A</p>	
<p><b>Equipment and/or materials required:</b>            Jerome needs his bucket filled with bottles.</p>	
<p><b>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person’s communication mode:</b>            Jerome communicates through vocalizations, reaching for things, eye gaze, adaptive switches, and facial expressions. Jerome best understands physical cues and one step verbal statements from those supporting him. Jerome will be supported by being asked in a short verbal requested, “Jerome, which would you like?” with a light physical cue.</p>
