<p>Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: Ann will go out into the community with PAI’s employment specialist at least once per month to work on finding a community job until next review.</p>	
<p>Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome: Ann is enrolled in employment services development as of 6/1/2021 and will begin working with PAI’s employment specialist weekly to find a job in the community.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Job searching, building a resume, filling out applications, etc. can all be done onsite at PAI when Ann starts her job search, but there is a great benefit to actually getting out in the community and visiting potential job sites, looking for applications, and practicing interviewing in different settings. 2. At least once a month, PAI’s employment specialist will schedule a community outing with Ann and let Ann know ahead of time. 3. Ann will make sure she attends PAI on that day and will dress appropriately for job searching in the community (clean clothes & business casual attire- dependent on the setting). On the outing, staff will model and encourage appropriate behavior. 	
<p>Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments: N/A</p>	
<p>Equipment and/or materials required: Internet access and an iPad provided by PAI.</p>	
<p>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person’s communication mode: Ann communicates verbally and takes verbal direction well. Ann will be verbally told about the outing ahead of time.</p>	
<p>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person’s learning style: Ann learns best through verbal direction. Staff will verbally let Ann know about the outing ahead of time and let her know where they are going. Staff will talk about the setting and encourage and coach Ann to dress appropriately for the setting. On the outing, staff will model and encourage appropriate behavior.</p>	
<p>Data collection method: A data tracking form will be used to record data. If Ann attends an outing in the community to work on searching for a job, staff will record a “y.” If Ann refuses to go out into the community to look for a job or is absent when she knew she had an outing scheduled, staff will record a “n.”</p>
