Outcome # 1

Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: Ann will use an iPad once a day as a relaxation activity and will return the iPad to the charging station, 75% of all trials for six months.

Summary of progress toward achieving this outcome: Ann achieved this outcome 80/90 trials or 89%.

Recommendation for implementing this outcome: Continue Change Discontinue

Rationale for the recommendation: Ann has achieved this outcome as written. Ann would like to continue working on her iPad skills and a new outcome will be started.

Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: Ann will pick and participate in 1 community activity per month for six months.

Summary of progress toward achieving this outcome: No data.

Recommendation for implementing this outcome: Continue Change Discontinue

Rationale for the recommendation: Ann still has the goal of staying active in her community- which has been especially hard this last year with covid-19. This outcome will be changed to Ann getting out in the community once a month 1:1 with an employment specialist to start looking for an independent community job.

Description of the person's status

Health: Ann has been in good health this review period and has not had any medical concerns.

What is currently important to the person and for the person: The important to Ann items are: working and trying new jobs, social relationships with peers, her family, and staying active in her community. The important for Ann items are: maintaining good health through eating well and stabilizing blood sugar levels and continuing to have opportunities in the community to work and for leisure activities.

Status of social relationships and natural supports: Ann's support team has remained consistent during this review period. Ann has a new case manager who she said she had not yet met. Ann has gotten back to some normal activities at home and has enjoyed having additional peers and staff return to PAI.

Recent inclusion and participation in the community: Community outings are currently on hold at PAI due to covid-19 health and safety concerns.

New or ongoing opportunities for the development and exercise of functional and age-appropriate skills, decision making and choice, personal advocacy, and communication: Ann does a good job advocating for herself at PAI and letting staff know which jobs she likes and dislikes. Ann is involved in making decisions that impact her. Ann chooses which classes she would like to participate in. Ann chooses where she would like to go on community outings (during normal circumstances, pre-covid).

Status of the person's civil and legal rights: Ann exercises her rights at PAI and does not have any right restrictions.
