**Summary of progress toward achieving this outcome:** Michelle has achieved this outcome 11/11 trials or 100%.

**Rationale for the recommendation:** Michelle has been back at PAI for about 2 months, after being gone for over a year for covid-19 closure/continued concerns. Before and after the break, Michelle has achieved this outcome at high percentages and is ready to move on to working on reciting the number out loud from memory.

**New or ongoing opportunities for the development and exercise of functional and age-appropriate skills, decision making and choice, personal advocacy, and communication:** When attending PAI, Michelle would choose how many leisure and skill building classes she wanted to take and which ones. Michelle would choose where she wanted to go on community outings. Michelle would be involved in making decisions that impacted her.
