Summary of Service Outcome and Support Progress

Outcome # 1

Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: Once daily, Teresa will choose a song for staff to sing to her in 90% of opportunities over the next six months.

Summary of progress toward achieving this outcome: Teresa has not had the opportunity to engage in this goal during this reporting period. Teresa has not returned to program since the site reopened July 27th, 2020.

Recommendation for implementing this outcome: Continue Change Discontinue

Rationale for the recommendation: Teresa has historically enjoyed this goal, prior to the COVID-19 closure Teresa would light up with a large smile and often sway when staff sang to her. During her annual meeting, the team decided it would be of benefit and interest to Teresa to resume this goal upon her return to PAI.

Outcome # 2

Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: Daily Teresa will indicate yes or no when asked to participate in a group activity in 80% of opportunities over the next six months.

Summary of progress toward achieving this outcome: Teresa has not had the opportunity to engage in this goal during this reporting period. Teresa has not returned to program since the site reopened July 27th, 2020.

Recommendation for implementing this outcome: Continue Change Discontinue

Rationale for the recommendation: Teresa has not returned to PAI during this reporting period. It is suggested that we continue this outcome, as it is important for her to make choices throughout her day. Teresa finds value in making choices and being independent with certain tasks.

Description of the person's status

Health:

Teresa has not attended program this reporting period due to the current Covid-19 pandemic. Teresa's Physician's Orders (dated 4/23/2019) have expired. Upon Teresa's return she will need to supply updated orders and medication.

What is currently important to the person and for the person:

Prior to PAI Covid-19 Site closure, it was **important to** that she has her string, that she spends time with preferred people and have her space when she would like it, that she has music in her life, that she maintains her independence, and that she have preferred foods and beverages.

It was **important for** Teresa that she continue to bear weight, that she has fluids daily, that she does not scratch her skin, and that she maintains good posture and sit upright in her wheelchair.

Status of social relationships and natural supports: Teresa had many friendships with peers and staff at PAI-Oakdale. She enjoyed spending time with people she knew well. She enjoyed the relationship with Legacy the therapy dog and her handle, Connie. Teresa's sisters were an important part of her life and she frequently opted to spend time with Gina and Cathy while at PAI and enjoyed visits from her other sisters on weekends.

Recent inclusion and participation in the community:

Teresa has not been supported in the community by PAI due to her attendance and the current pandemic.

New or ongoing opportunities for the development and exercise of functional and age-appropriate skills, decision making and choice, personal advocacy, and communication:

Teresa has not had any new or ongoing opportunities regarding the development and exercise of functional and age-appropriate skills, decision and choice making, personal advocacy, or communication this reporting period due to her attendance.

Status of the person's civil and legal rights:

Teresa has state guardianship provided by Margarita Godina of Ramsey County. It was reported during her annual meeting that Teresa's siblings would be looking into transferring guardianship over the next year.
