Summary of Service Outcome and Support Progress

Outcome # 1

Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: Carrie will participate in/attend a weekly iPad class, 75% of all trials until next review.

Summary of progress toward achieving this outcome: During the COVID-19 pandemic, there has not been an iPad class offered. However, Carrie has been great about using an iPad at PAI during breaks and downtime to practice this outcome independently.

Recommendation for implementing this outcome: Continue Change Discontinue

Rationale for the recommendation: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, PAI has not offered an iPad class. As Carrie has been diligent about practicing her iPad skills independently, Carrie looks forward to being in iPad class again when it is safe to do so and classes at PAI Commerce continue.

Description of the person's status

Health: During the review period, Carrie was diagnosed with COVID-19. However, Carrie has made a full recovery.

What is currently important to the person and for the person:

- Important to Carrie: Spending time with friends, having the opportunity to go to work
- Important for Carrie: Having patient staff that are receptive to Carrie's feelings, having the opportunity to make choices when available, having a set schedule that Carrie can depend on, having the opportunity to gain and maintain independence, improving social skills and self-advocacy skills

Status of social relationships and natural supports: Carrie maintains positive social relationships with peers, staff at PAI, and at home during this review period.

Recent inclusion and participation in the community: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, community outings have been put on hold. Carrie will resume attending community outings when it is a part of programming at PAI again.

New or ongoing opportunities for the development and exercise of functional and age-appropriate skills, decision making and choice, personal advocacy, and communication: Carrie makes appropriate decisions for herself and is involved in making decisions that affect her. Carrie chooses which and how many classes she would like to take at PAI and chooses to work on the work floor and/or in the community when not in class.

Status of the person's civil and legal rights: Carrie is under the guardianship of Jane Foley (her sister) and does not have any rights restrictions. Carrie exercises her rights at PAI.
