STRENGTHS, ROUTINES, & DREAMS: Andy is a young man, age 35, who lives in Newport. Andy resides in an ICF/DD home through Phoenix Residence. He lives with 5 other housemates and has staff support 24/7. Andy has a close relationship with his mother, Jenny and his step-father, Jon. They live in Florida and skype with Andy 1X week. Andy's mother visits at least 4X a year as well. Andy enjoys having BBQ's, swimming, going out to eat, people watching, music, and playing games and doing puzzles. Andy's strength is his ability to put together puzzles. It is not uncommon for Andy to be able to complete 3 puzzles at a time. Andy really likes when he has all the pieces to his puzzles. Andy is also very aware of his surroundings and picks up on others easily. Andy's daily routine is important to him. He does not accept new things very easily and it can take some time for him to adjust or adapt. Andy likes to have milk with his meals, and having an afternoon nap after getting home from work. Andy is tactile-defensive and doesn't like to be touched, especially on his face. Andy goes to Phoenix Alternative Inc (PAI) in Oakdale 3 days a week in the winter, and 4 during the summer. It's important to Andy to be out and about. It's important to him to have social interactions with others. Andy also likes the Minnesota Twins and Wisconsin Packers. He went to Disney world and he loved the roller-coasters and the dolphins. Per mom, Andy would love to go to Florida again. She would like for him to have another opportunity to swim with the dolphins. Andy's mom would also like for Andy to have access to swimming at Courage Kenny or other water activities, and have as many choices as possible during his day.

SUPPORTS DISCUSSED: N/A- Andy's mother reports that they are not interested in different services and supports for Andy. They are pleased with his residence and day program.

Supports Discussed at annual meeting on 4/1/21: Andy to go back to 4 days/week at PAI soon for the summer months. Discussed Andy continuing to wear his lap tray on his wheelchair to help with safety and stability, along with his foot rests. Jenny would love for Andy to get back into swimming again. Andy is also in need of a new lift system (TRAM) as he is needing more support during transfers.

Action Steps for Goals:

What will the person do?

Andy will continue to participate in activities that are preferred to him. He will indicate his wants and needs through use of his vocalizations, gestures and facial expressions. He will continue to participate in services and supports to build and maintain all skills necessary to achieve his goals.

What will the case manager do?

Case manager will monitor effectiveness of ongoing supports and services including: ICF/DD through Phoenix Residence, day services through PAI, and Rule-185 case management through Washington County. Case manager will provide referrals or authorizations as needed to support person's preferences, needs, desires and identified outcomes. Case manager will provide check-ins with person and team via phone or email as needed and will meet with him on a semi-annual basis or more as requested.

What will others do?

Andy's informal, and other formal supports will provide ongoing support, encouragement, advocacy, coordination of services, and access to additional supports and resources as available and appropriate to support his preferences, needs, desires, and identified outcomes. Andy's family will help plan a trip for Andy to get back to Florida to visit them in the future.

What will the provider do?

Andy's providers will provide ongoing support, encouragement, advocacy, coordination of services, and access to additional supports and resources as available and appropriate to support his preferences, needs, desires, and identified outcomes. His providers will ensure that he has a complete, safe, and desired plan of care. The Phoenix Residence and PAI will offer Andy as many choices as possible throughout his day. Phoenix Residence will assist Andy in swimming at the Courage Center again.
