Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: Weekly, John will choose a music genre using a two buttoned prerecorded Mack switch for 85% of all trials over a 12 month period.

Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome: Staff will record two different music genres onto a two buttoned Mack switch. Staff will push each button while showing John the button they pressed and give him time to hear each genre. Staff will ask John to choose a genre by pushing a Mack switch button. After John makes his choice staff will play more of the music he requested.

Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments: In a relatively quiet place so John can hear the music options.

Equipment and/or materials required: Mack switch

Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's communication mode: John appears to communicate using eye pointing, facial expressions, and reaching towards desired object.

Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's learning style: John's learning style appears to be auditory, visual, kinesthetic, and through repetition.

Data collection method: Data will be collected weekly.
