Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: Daily, John will choose an instrument to play while listening to music 95% of all trials over a 12 month period.

Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome: John will choose an instrument to play from two choices. Staff will say the instrument and show John. John will make his choice by reaching for an instrument, using facial expressions, body language, or vocalizations to make his choice. John may indicate he is not interested by turning his head away or dropping the instrument.

Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments: Music playing

Equipment and/or materials required: instrument choices

Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's communication mode: John appears to communicate using eye pointing, facial expressions, and reaching towards desired object.

Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's learning style: John's learning style appears to be auditory, visual, kinesthetic, and through repetition.

Data collection method: Data will be collected daily.
