<p>Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement:</p> <p>Twice a week, Matthew will greet a peer with a MAC switch 80% of all trials over a 12-month period.</p>	
<p>Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome: Staff will ask Matthew if he would like to greet a peer. Staff will present Matthew with a Mac switch that is prerecorded with a greeting, (i.e.- “Good morning” “Good afternoon” “Hello” “Hi”, etc.) and ask Matthew to greet his peer and/or press the MAC switch.</p>	
<p>Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments: N/A</p>	
<p>Equipment and/or materials required: MAC switch</p>	
<p>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person’s communication mode:</p> <p>Expressive: Matt is non-verbal. He does however vocalize purposefully and appropriately uses the term “uh-oh!” Matt also successfully answers yes or no questions by communicating “yes” with the vocalization “UHHHHH”. Matt communicates “no” by looking away or appearing to ignore whomever is asking the question. Matt also engages in laughter, happy vocalizations, and jumping up and down to communicate he is happy, pleased, excited. Matt communicates he is upset by engaging in negative vocalizations.</p> <p>Receptive: Matt’s receptive communication is observed to be fair. When Matt is not struggling with sensory integration needs (overstimulated), he demonstrates an ability to follow short prompts and directives. Matt also responds to yes or no questions.</p>
