What will the person do? What will the case manager do?

The case manager will continue to monitor, evaluate, and coordinate with informal and formal supports and with Ted and his guardian to ensure all of his health and safety needs are being met. The case manager will also assist Ted and guardian by making referral to services and providers as requested by Ted and his guardian.

Case manager will continue to work with Ted to build and maintain all skills to meet his goals and to ensure all his health and safety needs are met. Case manager will work with Ted to encourage/support on his global goals/dreams and be in regular contacts with English House and his guardian on the progress of his goals/dreams. Case manager will work with Ted to help him achieve his goals of continue to live at English House and receives support he needs to maintain independent as possible as well as return to participate in PAI, a day program that he enjoys. CM to monitor services Ted receives, and assist with resolving conflict with providers as needed.

What will others do?

FAMILY: Ted's family will continue to provide Ted with the informal supports and encouragement to assure Ted's health and safety needs are met 24/7/365 days a year, as well as help his build and maintain all skills to accomplish his goals and dreams in life. Ted 's family will continue to work with Ted in an Ted centered manner to achieve his global goals/dreams of continue to live at English House and receives support he needs to maintain independent as possible as well as return to participate in PAI, a day program that he enjoys.

Guardian will continue to exercise their powers and responsibilities, unless stated differently in the guardianship order, of: establishing place of abode (residential); care, comfort and maintenance needs; personal property; medical care; contracts; exercise supervisory authority; and assure eligibility for government benefits; They will complete their annual filing responsibilities as mandated by the court. They will work with Ted to build and maintain all skills to meet his goals of continue to live at English House and receives support he needs to maintain independent as possible as well as return to participate in PAI, a day program that he enjoys. Guardian will work with Ted and ensure all his health and safety needs are met.

REPRESENTATIVE PAYEE will continue to assist with money management; assist with completion of all documents to maintain eligibility for state and federal benefit programs.

What will the provider do?

PAI/residential provider will continue to work with Ted to build and maintain all skills to meet his goals of continue to live at English House and receives support he needs to maintain independent as possible as well as return to participate in PAI, a day program that he enjoys. DT&H will continue to work with Ted to build and maintain employment and vocational skills to meet his goals, and to ensure his health and safety needs are met during their scheduled time.

RISKS

How will Health and Safety Issues be Addressed?

The English House provides a 24-hour plan of care for Ted. This is the appropriate level of supervision for Ted.

Ted needs a guardian, rep payee, and support services staff to help ensure his basic needs are met. Quintin acts as his court appointed guardian and help him make legal decisions.

English House, acts as his rep payee and work with his guardian to complete all paperwork for his government benefits.

Private guardian and English House work together to ensure Ted's basic needs are met, i.e. food, shelter, and clothing.

Ted has an IDD case manager that works with the team to ensure his services needs are being met by providers.

His team works together to protect Ted as a vulnerable adult.

There are no plans to move him or change his services at this time. Ted and his guardian work with his IDD case manager on service and provider options to meet his health and safety needs
