### Description of the person's status

**Health:** Kathy has not had any major health related events or incident reports while at PAI during this review period.

**Medications and treatments received at PAI:**

Baclofen 10mg- Give 1 tablet by mouth with food or milk – Once daily at noon

Gabapentin 300MG – Give 1 capsule by mouth- Once daily at noon

Acetaminophen 325MG – Give 2 tablets as needed every 4 hours

Nitroglycerin- Oral Spray – As needed (Follow the Chest Pain Protocol)

**What is currently important to the person and for the person:**

- **Important to:** It is important to Kathy to have opportunities to participate in activities she enjoys, such as coloring in adult coloring books, playing games like Bingo, going shopping out in the community, and socializing with peers and staff that she enjoys spending time with.
- **Important for:** It is important for Kathy to manage her health by staying active and engaged in activities she enjoys. It is important for Kathy to advocate for herself if she is experiencing any pain or discomfort so that staff can assist her if/when needed.

**Status of social relationships and natural supports:** Kathy lives at PRI Ludden house and has opportunities to attend community outings there. Kathy has a strong relationship with her family.

**Recent inclusion and participation in the community:** Due to COVID-19, Kathy has not had the opportunity to spend time in the community with PAI.

**New or ongoing opportunities for the development and exercise of functional and age-appropriate skills, decision making and choice, personal advocacy, and communication:**

- **Age-appropriate skills**
  - Pet Therapy: Due to COVID-19 Kathy has not been able to participate in pet therapy.
  - Music Therapy: Due to COVID-19 Kathy is not able to participate in music therapy
  - Group Activities: Due to Covid-19 Kathy is not able to participate in group activities.
  - Afternoon Activities: Due to Covid-19 Kathy is not able to participate in afternoon activities.
- **Decision making and choice:** Kathy makes choices about her schedule, community activities, and daily activities. She is provided options throughout her day to make choices and decisions. Her decisions are honored.
- **Personal Advocacy:** Kathy is a strong personal advocate and will communicate when she has a need. Kathy is encouraged and supported in her communication to have her needs and desires met. It is important that she have support people around her that know her well and advocate for the needs and desires that she may not be able to communicate to the appropriate team members.
- **Communication:** Kathy communicates verbally, gestures, and facial expressions.

**Status of the person's civil and legal rights:** Kathy has private guardians.

**Other information as requested by the support team, please indicate:** Kathy and her team have recently decided that they would like her to return to PAI. Due to the high number of participants wanting to return to PAI, we have started a waiting list, which Kathy is on. We are hoping to have her back soon.
