<p>Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement:</p> <p>Daily, Deanna will make a sensory activity choice by touching the object she would like in 75% of opportunities over the next year.</p>
<p>Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome:</p> <p>Deanna will be presented with two sensory objects such as bubbles and hand lotion. She will be asked to choose which one she would like to do. She will be provided time to process the questions and make her choice. Deanna will reach out and touch items she would like or take them out of staff's hand. She may also laugh.</p> <p>If Deanna does not choose a sensory activity, she will be provided with different options and asked to make a choice.</p> <p>Once Deanna makes a choice, she will have the opportunity to participate in the activity soon after and the outcome will be documented as achieved.</p>
<p>Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments:</p> <p>Deanna will run this outcome in her program room.</p>
<p>Equipment and/or materials required:</p> <p>Hand massager, lotion, bubbles, weighted blanket, hairbrush and/or iPad with Sensory sounds/video.</p>
<p>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's communication mode:</p> <p>Deanna communicates by using vocalizations, gestures, and facial expressions. Deanna understands short verbal communications that may or may not be paired with physical cues or objects.</p>
<p>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's learning style:</p> <p>Deanna's learning style appears to be auditory, visual, and kinesthetic.</p>
<p>Data collection method:</p> <p>Data will be collected monthly after the outcome is run.</p>
