Daily, Matthew will communicate with staff when he needs to use the restroom with 2 or less sight picture prompts for a 6 month overall average 85% or more of all trials.	
Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Matthew communicates through modified signs, body gestures, and vocalizations. He responds to visual sign language and short physical prompts. • Daily when Matthew needs to use the restroom, staff will sign to him “bathroom” and shown a picture of a toilet. Matt will then be given time to process. • Staff may also independently sign bathroom or give the picture symbol to staff. • Should Matt not respond he will be given a second sign for bathroom and the picture. 	
Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments: NA	
Equipment and/or materials required: Picture symbol of the toilet (which will be displayed in is program room next to the bathroom).	
Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person’s communication mode:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Matt communicates by eye gazing, vocalizations, reaching for things he wants or pushing way things he does not want, and some ASL signs (bathroom, eat, and drink). • Matt understands short verbal phrases pared with signs or physical cues. Matt understands ASL signs of friends, walk, later, eat, bathroom, drink, sit, outside 	
Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person’s learning style:	
Matt’s learning style appears to be visual and through a structured routine.

Data will be collected daily, after Matt advocated for himself to use the restroom.
