Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: Tish has expressed interest in learning to use ASL. This outcome allows Tish the opportunity to work on this skill while maintaining appropriate communication around a private matter. Daily, Tish will indicate that she needs to use the cares room by signing "restroom" in 80% of all opportunities over the next year.
Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome: When Tish arrives, staff will let her know to inform them when she needs to use the restroom. Staff will show Tish the sign for restroom until a routine is created. When Tish informs staff that she needs to use the restroom by signing, the outcome will be documented as achieved (y) and she will be assisted to complete her cares. If Tish verbally communicates with her staff that she needs to use the cares room, staff will remind Tish of the sign and assist her in using the cares room. If Tish does not use the sign for "restroom," this outcome will be documented as not achieved (n).
Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments: There are no changes to the environment needed.
Equipment and/or materials required: No additional materials are needed.
Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's communication mode: Tish understands verbal communication and communicates to others verbally. Tish may need additional time to process what has been said to her or to express herself. When she is nervous or uncomfortable it tends to take her longer to share information.
Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's learning style: Tish is very intelligent and has a great memory. Tish works well with positive reminders and reassurance. Consistency will also be very important for Tish.
Data collection method: Documentation will be recorded and charted daily. Charting will include a "Y" or "N" indicating success.
Names of staff or positions responsible for implementing the supports and methods: Designated Coordinator (DC), Lead Direct Support Professional (LDSP), and Direct Support Professionals (DSP).
