Donald is encouraged to engage with staff daily. ### Description of the person's status

**Health:** Donald has had no medical concerns at PAI during this period of review.

**Medications administered at PAI:** *(Please review & notify PAI immediately if you identify any discrepancy in the information below)*

- **Valproic Acid** 250mg/5ml - Give 450mg/9ml via g-tube at noon
- **Sodium Chloride** 1000mg - Give 1 1000mg tablet, crushed via g-tube at noon
- **Baclofen** 30 mg - Give 30mg, crushed via g-tube at noon
- **Replete w/Fiber** - Give 250ml with 60ml water flush after dispensing of medication via g-tube at noon
- **Water flush** – Give 110cc water via g-tube at noon
- **Diazepam** 5mg/1ml - Give 10mg/2ml buccally as needed for seizure activity

**What is currently important to the person and for the person:**

- **Important to:** It is important to Donald to have the opportunity to go on outings, listen to music, hear people sing, watching movies, and being talked to and engaged by staff and caregivers. Donald has shown that enjoys horse riding, going bowling, dancing, and moving, and going to parades and concerts. It is important to Donald that he can participate in these types of activities that he especially enjoys. It is important to Donald that he can visit and socialize with staff and peers, as he is a very social man who values connection and interaction. It is important to Donald that he has his manipulatives available to him.
- **Important for:** It is important for Donald to receive care from providers and staff that are trained in how best to serve him. It is important for Donald that he can use his urinal while in the cares room to encourage independence with his toileting. It is important for Donald to have the opportunity to visit and socialize with staff and peers, to maintain his social skills.

**Status of social relationships and natural supports:** Donald lives at ACR at 16<sup>th</sup> Ave. He has the opportunity to attend outings while at home, as well as while at PAI. Donald has many opportunities to cultivate social relationships and interactions with his peers while at PAI day program.

**Recent inclusion and participation in the community:** Due to COVID-19 Donald has had limited opportunity to spend time in the community with PAI. PAI has only recently returned to participating in the greater community as restrictions have eased and vaccination rates have increased. Donald had the opportunity to attend a community outing to Good Will. Donald was observed smiling, laughing, and having positive vocalization while out in the community and seemed to enjoy spending time out with peers and staff.

**New or ongoing opportunities for the development and exercise of functional and age-appropriate skills:**

**Pet Therapy:** Donald has had the opportunity to participate in Pet Therapy with Midnight & Zelda the therapy dogs. Donald often smiles & laughs during visits with the therapy dogs and is accepting of hand over hand assistance to pet the dogs. Donald has also been observed to reaching out to pet / interact with the dogs independently.

**Music Therapy:** This reporting period Donald participated in Music Therapy both virtually and in-person. Donald shows his enjoyment of Music Therapy by smiling, laughing, and accepting hand over hand assistances while playing the instruments. Donald enjoys a variety of music genres but really responds to upbeat music and appears to particularly enjoy music by Adel.

**Morning and afternoon activities:** Donald participates in different game activities such as UNO, Phase 10, Sequence and other card/board games. Donald makes choices by eye pointing when holding up two different cards to choose from. Donald tolerates hand over hand assistances when needed while playing games. Donald is encourage to participate in arts and crafts activities and does well communicating his choices. Donald tolerates well with hand over hand assistance and making choices by eye pointing. Donald has made several national and holiday crafts along with a

canvas that Donald assisted with which won an art contest for the Walk, Run, and Roll event. Donald participates in some sensory throughout the day. Donald is also offered some light range of motion exercises and repositioning. Donald also participates in daily reading groups.

Groups: Donald consistently attends several group activities at PAI. Donald appears to enjoy playing Bingo with peers as observed by Donald tolerating hand over hand assistance to spin the wheel, along with smiling and laughing. Donald does well with choice making via eye-pointing to choose an item when he wins Bingo. Donald also seems to enjoy being read to during Story Group as observed by his smiling, laughing, and making positive vocalizations when staff read to Donald and his peers. Donald enjoys scary stories especially when in a different language as observed Donald laughing and giggling. Donald is offered choices of stories and seems to enjoy choosing which one staff will to read to him and his peers. Donald also participates in All About MN where he uses various technologies such a the iPad, computer or a book to learn about & explore Minnesota. Donald is often observed to be alert and engaged during this group, along with smiling, laughing, and making positive vocalizations.

**Decision making and choice:** Donald makes choices about his schedule, community activities, and daily activities using facial expressions and body language. He is provided options throughout his day to make choices and decisions. His decisions are honored.

**Personal Advocacy:** Donald is a strong personal advocate and will communicate when he has a need. Donald is encouraged and supported in his communication to have his needs and desires met. It is important that he have support people around him that know him well and advocate for the needs and desires that he may not be able to communicate to the appropriate team members.

**Communication:** Donald communicates through facial expressions, vocalizations, and gestures. Donald is encouraged to communicate his wants and needs throughout his day.
