Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: <b>Twice a week, Jason will participate / join a group activity of his choosing 80% of all trials over a six month period.</b>		
<b>Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome:</b> Jason enjoys a variety of group activities at times but also enjoys relaxing while at program while observing his peers during activities. Jason needs lots of encouragement to participate in activities, even in activities he enjoys. This goal allows for Jason to have a balance between rest and social opportunities while continuing to strengthen his choice making and communication skills.  <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Twice weekly, in a calm/quiet environment Jason will be encouraged to choose a group to participate.</li> <li>2. Jason will be verbally informed of his options for groups and asked if he would like to participate.</li> <li>3. Staff will review the options with Jason and will watch for Jason's for nonverbal communication indicating he would like to participate.  <div style="padding-left: 40px;">Jason uses facial expression, gestures and body language to communicate. Jason may also point to his preference if provided with physical options.</div> </li> </ol> <p>If Jason use his communication skills to choose a group and then participates in the group, the outcome will be documented as achieved (y)</p> <p>Should Jason not choose a group or choose to not participate at the scheduled time of the group, the outcome will be documented as not achieved (n)</p>		
<b>Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments:</b> Jason has a visual impairment and prefers to observe an activity prior to participating. Jason will be given time to observe the activity and his peers during group prior to being encouraged to participate.		
<b>Equipment and/or materials required:</b> Group choices		
<b>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's communication mode:</b> Jason uses facial expression, gestures and body language to communicate most readily. Jason may use some ASL signs and also may point to his preference if provided with physical options. Jason responds best when encouraged by staff.		
<b>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's learning style:</b> Jason learns through modeling, hand-over-hand assistance, verbal cues and touch prompts/pointing. Jason also benefits from routine & repetition.		
<b>Data collection method:</b> Documentation will be recorded and charted 2x weekly. Charting will include a Y or N indicating success
