<p>Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Daily, Christina will choose a sensory activity to participate in, in 80% of all opportunities over the next 12 months.</p>
<p>Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome:</p> <p>Staff will approach Christina in an upbeat tone. She will be shown the various sensory activities that she can participate in, using the iPad or physical items. Staff will allow Christina adequate time to process and respond. Christina will indicate a preference by establishing eye contact, making vocalizations, facial expressions, using the iPad, or reaching for the desired item(s). If Christina makes an activity choice, this outcome will be documented as "Y" for achieved and Christina will be assisted in participating in the desired activity. If she does not make a choice, this outcome will be documented as "N" for not achieved.</p>
<p>Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments:</p> <p>Christina needs a quiet environment where she can focus on the question.</p>
<p>Equipment and/or materials required:</p> <p>Christina needs access to sensory activities.</p>
<p>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's communication mode:</p> <p>Christina communicates non-verbally by establishing eye contact, making vocalizations, facial expressions, and using her communication devices. She will point to or grab things she wants and dropping things she does not want. Christina is receptive to short verbal phrases in English, delivered in a friendly tone, and physical cues. Christina has a hearing impairment, so it is important to stand in front of Christina when speaking to her and make eye contact if able.</p>
<p>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's learning style:</p> <p>Christina learns through repetition once a routine has been established. She is best supported with modeling, verbal, and physical prompts.</p>
<p>Data collection method:</p> <p>This outcome will be recorded and charted daily. Charting will include a "Y" or "N" indicating success.</p>
<p>Names of staff or positions responsible for implementing the supports and methods:</p> <p>Program Supervisor (PS), Lead Direct Support Professional (LDSP) and Direct Support Professionals (DSP).</p>
