Outcome # 1

**Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement:** Daniel will respond appropriately when greeted by peers or staff on 80% of all trials over a 6-month period.

**Summary of progress toward achieving this outcome:** Dan has achieved this outcome 101/103 trials or 98%.

**Recommendation for implementing this outcome:**  Continue     Change     Discontinue

**Rationale for the recommendation:** Dan has achieved this outcome consistently over several months. A new outcome will be developed to continue working on social skills at PAI.

Outcome # 2

**Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement:** Daniel will work at a community-based job site when offered twice per month on 80% of all trial over a 6-month period.

**Summary of progress toward achieving this outcome:** No data.

**Rationale for the recommendation:** Community based work has not been available at PAI for over a year due to covid-19 and other factors. Dan has a community job at one point, but no longer does. This outcome will be discontinued and a new one started.
