Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: Mark will press a mac switch to visit another program room a minimum of once weekly in 85% or more of trials until his next review.		
Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome: Mark is a very social man and likes to experience activities in the other program rooms. This outcome allows Mark to engage in something he enjoys while continuing to strengthen his communication skills using mac switches. This outcome will be trialed a minimum of once weekly.		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mark will be offered a Mac switch that has been pre-recorded requesting to visit another program room and asked if he would like to visit. 2. If Mark is interested in visiting, he will press the Mac switch to request to visit. 		
If Mark uses the Mac switch to request to visit the outcome will be documented as achieved (y) and staff will support Mark to visit with others in the area of his choosing.		
Should Mac not use the Mac switch to request to visit, the outcome will be documented as not achieved (n) and it will be assumed that Mark is not interested in visiting at this time.		
Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments: Mark has a visual impairment causing blurry vision, staff will verbally explain what they are showing Mark.		
Equipment and/or materials required: Prerecorded Mac switch requesting to visit		
Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's communication mode: Mark communicates through facial expressions, vocalizations, and gestures. He may look away or push something away if he is not interested.		
Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's learning style: Mark learns through routine & repetition. Mark appears to be an auditory, visual and kinesthetic learner. Mark understands short verbal requests in English and responds to physical prompts.		
Data collection method: Documentation will be recorded & charted a minimum of once weekly. Charting will include a Y or N indicating success		
Names of staff or positions responsible for implementing the supports and methods: Program Supervisor (PS), Lead Direct Support Professional (LDSP) and Direct Support Professionals (DSP)		

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
