Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement:

Mark will choose a video to watch three times a week in 85% or more of trials until his next review.

Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome: Mark enjoys watching videos alone & with peers. This outcome allows Mark to engage in something he enjoys while continuing to strengthen his choice making skills and ability to communicate preferences.

1. Mark will be offered a choice of 2 videos to watch.
2. Staff will play a clip of each video and observe Mark for nonverbal communication.
 Mark may indicate he is interested in a video by smiling, positive vocalizations, or positive body language.
 Mark may indicated he does not like a video by turning away or having negative vocalizations.

If Mark uses his nonverbal communication skills to indicate a video preference, the outcome will be documented as achieved (y) and staff will support Mark to watch the video of his choosing.

Should Mark not indicate a video preference, the outcome will be documented as not achieved (n) and it will be assumed that Mark is not interested in watching a video at this time.

Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments:

Mark has a visual impairment causing blurry vision, staff will verbally explain what they are showing Mark and ensure the videos are within his field of view.

Equipment and/or materials required:

iPad or computer, 2 video options

Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's communication mode:

Mark communicates through facial expressions, vocalizations, and gestures. He may look away or push something away if he is not interested. Mark understands verbal communications.

Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's learning style:

Mark learns through routine & repetition. Mark appears to be an auditory, visual and kinesthetic learner. Mark understands short verbal requests in English and responds to physical prompts.

Data collection method:

Documentation will be recorded & charted a minimum of once weekly. Charting will include a Y or N indicating success
