Description of the person's status

Health: Abe's health has remained consistent since his last reporting period.

What is currently important to the person and for the person: Important to Abe is spending time with friends, being with his family on the weekends and having consistency to his schedule. Important for Abe is learning and using coping skills, learning things to help gain his independence, working out to stay physically healthy and being included in making decisions that affect him.

Status of social relationships and natural supports: Abe has not yet been able to attend PAI in person. He has been doing remote services through PAI and has been able to interact with staff and occasionally say hi to new friends who are on-site at PAI.

Recent inclusion and participation in the community: Abe is currently enrolled in Remote Services only.

New or ongoing opportunities for the development and exercise of functional and age-appropriate skills, decision making and choice, personal advocacy, and communication: Abe continues to advocate on his own behalf and let staff know which topics he would like to research and learn each day through Remote Services. Once Abe attends PAI on-site, he will choose which classes he would like to take at PAI and how many classes he would like to take. Each month, Abe will have the opportunity to choose which outing he would like to attend.

Status of the person's civil and legal rights: Abe exercises his rights with PAI and does not have any right restrictions.
