Description of the person's status

Health: TéVon has been in good health during this reporting period.

What is currently important to the person and for the person: It is important to TéVon that he have opportunities to use technology such as the iPad, computer, or SMARTBoard to play music and watch videos during his day. It is also important to him that he has time to spend with his favorite staff and that he has people to sing, dance and interact with during his day. It is important for TéVon that use his communication skills, that he be as independent as possible, and that he continues to be physically active and get in his stander.

Status of social relationships and natural supports: TéVon's family continues to be an active and important part of his life. Té lives with his mother, Barbara, and enjoys visiting with family. TéVon continues to have strong relationships with his support staff, frequently choosing to visit with staff around the building or in their offices. TéVon's is always welcoming of new staff, participants, and visitors in the building.

Recent inclusion and participation in the community: Due to COVID-19, TéVon has not been visiting his greater community.

New or ongoing opportunities for the development and exercise of functional and age-appropriate skills, decision making and choice, personal advocacy, and communication:

Functional and age-appropriate skills: TéVon has had the opportunity to participate in music therapy in person, this reporting period. This seems to be one of his favorite activities. He enjoys singing with his peers, but also enjoys strumming the guitar, playing the drums, and shaking the maracas. He is able to play most of the instruments with minimal assistance. TéVon has also participated in pet therapy this reporting period. A new pet therapist, named Tracy, started with her dog, Benny. TéVon is often asking about them during the week. Decision Making and Choice: Choices are offered to TéVon throughout his day so he can make his own decisions. TéVon tends to communicate verbally; however, he may point or use a communication board to make a choice.

Personal Advocacy: TéVon is encouraged and supported in his communication to have his needs and desires met. It is important to TéVon that he has staff around him that he is comfortable communicating with.

Communication: TéVon tends to communicate verbally; however, he may also point or use a communication board. Staff honor TéVon's communication and the choices that he makes throughout his day.

Status of the person's civil and legal rights: TéVon is provided private guardianship provided by his mother, Barbara Joseph. TéVon's civil and legal rights continue to be protected at PAI. TéVon would like to be aware of his rights and have a support team who is also aware and advocate on his behalf.
