 **Person-Centered Thinking Exploration** (4 session Virtual Classroom)
Person-Centered Thinking® (PCT) is a set of values, skills and tools that underlies the work we do to support people to have a meaningful life. In times of uncertainty, PCT gives us with a way of thinking about how to provide services that give people positive control and self-direction over the lives they choose to lead. To help you learn more about PCT skills, we created a four-part training series designed for those who have not taken the full two-day PCT training. This exploration training will introduce some of the main concepts from the full PCT training curriculum. If you have taken the full course, you can still attend this series as a refresher.

 **Writing Positive Support Strategies: Everyone Needs Them!** * (Virtual Classroom)
Recent 245D correction orders are showing an increase in violations related to the requirements for Positive Support Strategies (PSS). Does your documentation reflect the PSS requirements in 245D and the Positive Supports Rule? You may be asking, what are they? What does my documentation need to include to adequately address PSS? Since everyone you support is required to have PSS in place, come and learn how to develop these strategies in a person-centered and practical way.  **Writing the Individual Abuse Prevention Plan*** (Virtual Classroom)
The Individual Abuse Prevention Plan (IAPP) is a document many people write quickly upon admission but fail to properly update to adequately reflect a person's needs. An improperly written IAPP not only leaves the person more vulnerable to abuse, neglect and finance exploitation due to unprepared staff, but it can also increase liability for a provider if the written plans are considered inadequate during times of maltreatment investigations.  **Designated Coordinator/Manager Development Program**
All 245D licensed programs are required to have a Designated Coordinator (DC) and Designated Manager (DM). The DC and DM at your agency need to have a clear understanding of the requirements in MN Statutes, chapter 245D and MN Rules, chapter 9544 to ensure your agency's success! The Designated Coordinator and Manager Development Program is an interactive course designed to help participants gain the knowledge, confidence, and skills necessary to be a successful Designated Coordinator or Designated Manager, especially for Intensive 245D Services. *9:00 am - 4:30 pm \$1,299 CEUs: 25.2 for Nurses, 21 for Social Workers*

 **Overview of 9544: The Positive Supports Rule*** (Classroom or Virtual)
"I didn't even know about this Rule! I thought I only needed to follow 245D! Isn't this only for providers who use emergency restraints?" Providers are often caught off guard when faced with a licensing citation for Rule 9544 (the Positive Supports Rule) during their 245D licensing visit. All 245D providers must also comply with 9544 and your licensor will be checking! In this course, you will learn the basics of the Positive Supports Rule.
