2022 Student Poster Board Project

This project is designed to develop student skills to professionally communicate and promote their profession. In addition, it encourages the students to engage in research for the purpose of expanding their own knowledge. Student poster boards should reflect accuracy of the profession and in addition professional appearance (centering, neat lines, organized, detailed, fluid articulation etc...).

Each assigned student group will prepare a professional grade poster board on a topic that correlates with the profession (see assignment below). Poster board topics must be approved by faculty. Poster boards will be on display during NRTW in the school rotunda.

Submission of Poster Board Topic: **Monday, September 12, 2022, by 1600**

Submission of Poster Board: **Wednesday October 26, 2022, by 1600**

Assignment Requirements:

Literature Review

- A minimum of 5 sources from radiography-related journals, books or websites is required. Radiography related websites must be from credible sources (org., edu., gov.), and websites are limited to 3 for poster content.
- Sources must be no older than 5 years.
- Sources and citations for the content and the reference page for student entries must in APA format
- The reference page is to be attached to the back of the poster with tape.

Mechanics

- The display can either be a trifold corrugated presentation board with a header (both any color) 48" wide X 36" high or a digitally printed poster not larger than 2' X 3'.
 - The poster display must be contained on one side of a presentation board or in the space allotted for the digitally printed poster.
- The use of view boxes is not permitted.
- Content may be displayed in power point format on the poster.
- Original radiographs are not acceptable. Photographs of radiographs may be used with all personal information removed from the image.
- The poster must contain a header with the project title.

Expectations:

- **Plagiarism will not be tolerated and disciplinary action will follow SHS 307 Academic Integrity policy.**

- Poster board may not have been previously published, printed, or presented before.
- Participation in research, design and assembly of the poster board must occur by each student in the assigned group.
- If any information is inaccurate or multiple grammar and/or spelling errors occur, the assigned group will be accountable to correct the information prior to having it displayed during NRTW.
