1. Review assigned reading (project preparation), perform a web search. (30 minutes)
2. Develop an education plan based on answering the 6 project statements. (30 minutes)
3. Provide education on the 6 project statements to family member or friend. (15 minutes)
4. Evaluate the education session using the Clinical Judgment Questions. (15 minutes)
5. Complete Submission Form & submit electronically to Edvance360 Drop Box. (30 minutes)

Project Statements (information you will provide in your education):

1. Explain HIPAA & why it is important for everyone.
2. Describe what can happen to a student nurse that violates HIPAA regulations.
3. Provide 2 examples of what a student nurse should NOT post on social media.
4. Share how others can help nurses maintain professional boundaries on social media.
5. Explain 2 preparation measures a student nurse performs to provide adequate client care.
6. Review that student nurses CAN be held liable for the care they provide to clients.

Clinical Judgment Questions (Used by student to evaluate education session):

1. (Noticing) Was the learner engaged in the education presented? How do you know?
2. (Interpreting) Did the learner understand the presented information? How do you know?
3. (Responding) How did you assure the education was clearly communicated?
4. (Reflecting) How could you improve your education presentation in the future?

**NRS101 Legal Project Submission Form (submit to Edvance360 Drop Box)**

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Brief (1-2 sentences) description of education provided regarding "Project Statements"

1. HIPAA protects patient health information from being disclosed without the patient's consent or knowledge. It is important for everyone to know about HIPAA because it is important that people know their rights.
2. Violation of HIPAA by a student nurse can lead to disciplinary action, include termination and punishment by the board of nursing.
3. The student nurse should not post the patient on social media. Any information pertaining the patient should not be posted on social media.
4. A way to help a nurse maintain professional boundaries is not sharing inappropriate post on his/her social media page.
5. Two preparations are identifying the right patient name, date of birth, and scanning bracelet ID. Another preparation is gathering the proper equipment for assessments or any procedure done.
6. Student nurses are health care professionals and can be liable for the care they provide to clients. Student nurses are held to the same standards of care as licensed nurses and can be held liable if they do not provide adequate care.

Brief Answers to Clinical Judgment Questions:

1. The learner was engaged in the education presented because they asked questions about the topic.
2. The learner understood the information presented because they were talking among each other about the information.
3. A assured the education was clearly communicated by not using medical terms and talking at their comprehension level.
