**Speaker Qualifications:**

Tom Arneson is the Research Manager at the Office of Medical Cannabis within the MN Department of Health. He provides a clinical and research perspective to implementation of the state's medical cannabis program and oversees research on the program's impact. His career has included positions focused on population health research and medical quality improvement. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Harvard, his Doctor of Medicine degree from Mayo, and his Masters of Public Health degree from the University of Minnesota. He is board certified in Public Health and General Preventative Medicine.

Cody Wiberg, the Executive Director of the Minnesota Board of Pharmacy, received a Doctor of Pharmacy from the University of Minnesota in 1985. He has worked as a clinical pharmacist, community pharmacist and nursing home consultant. From 1999, until he joined the Board in September of 2005, he was the Pharmacy Program Manager for the Minnesota Department of Human Services. Dr. Wiberg is a Clinical Assistant Professor for the University of Minnesota College of Pharmacy and an Instructor and Course Director for the University of Florida Graduate School. (From which he received a Master of Science in Pharmacy Policy and Outcomes in 2009). He is also a course director for the University of Wyoming Graduate School. Dr. Wiberg was named to Minnesota Physician's quadrennial list of the state's 100 Most Influential Health Care Leaders in 2008, 2012 and 2016. He received the 2017 Century Mortar Club Friend of the College Award from the University of Minnesota, College of Pharmacy.
