*Animal Cruelty, Bedwetting, Pyromania*

- **Animal Cruelty** – Practice \_\_\_\_\_ techniques on \_\_\_\_\_ before moving onto humans.  
*Dahmer often mutilated and tortured stray dogs*
- **Bed-wetting** – 60% of serial killers \_\_\_\_\_ their bed \_\_\_\_\_ adolescence

### MOs and Signatures

- **Modus Operandi** refers to common aspects of the criminal's \_\_\_\_\_ that might change according to circumstances (e.g., means of access, \_\_\_\_\_ of weapons).
- **Signatures** are \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_, revealing psychological needs (e.g., ritual aspects of crime, nicknames, posing the corpse, inserting objects).
- Latter more useful for *linkage analysis* – determining if same individual is responsible for various crimes.

### Souvenirs and Trophies

### Geographic Areas

### Female Serial Killers

Tend to use \_\_\_\_\_, kill those close to them and profit or “mercy” is the motive.

- **Black Widows** – kill \_\_\_\_\_ for inheritance or \_\_\_\_\_.
