Facts!

- First published poet in America as a woman.
- She emigrated to the New World in 1630 on the Arbella ship.
- Her dad and husband played an important role in the founding of Harvard University in 1630.
- Her poems were originally published without her consent
- She wrote a touching poem about married love.
- The cause of her death was consumption being wasted to skin and bones
- Her house burnt down in 1666
- She also wrote about the 4 elements
