

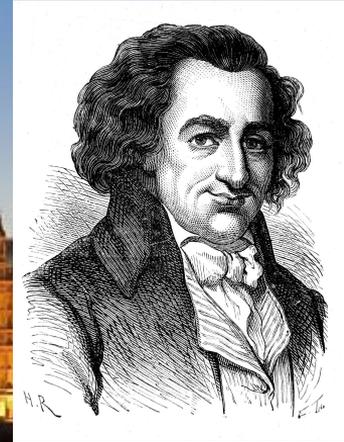

Thomas Paine was born in 1737, February 9. He was born at Thetford, Norfolk England. His parents were Frances Cocke and Joseph Paine.



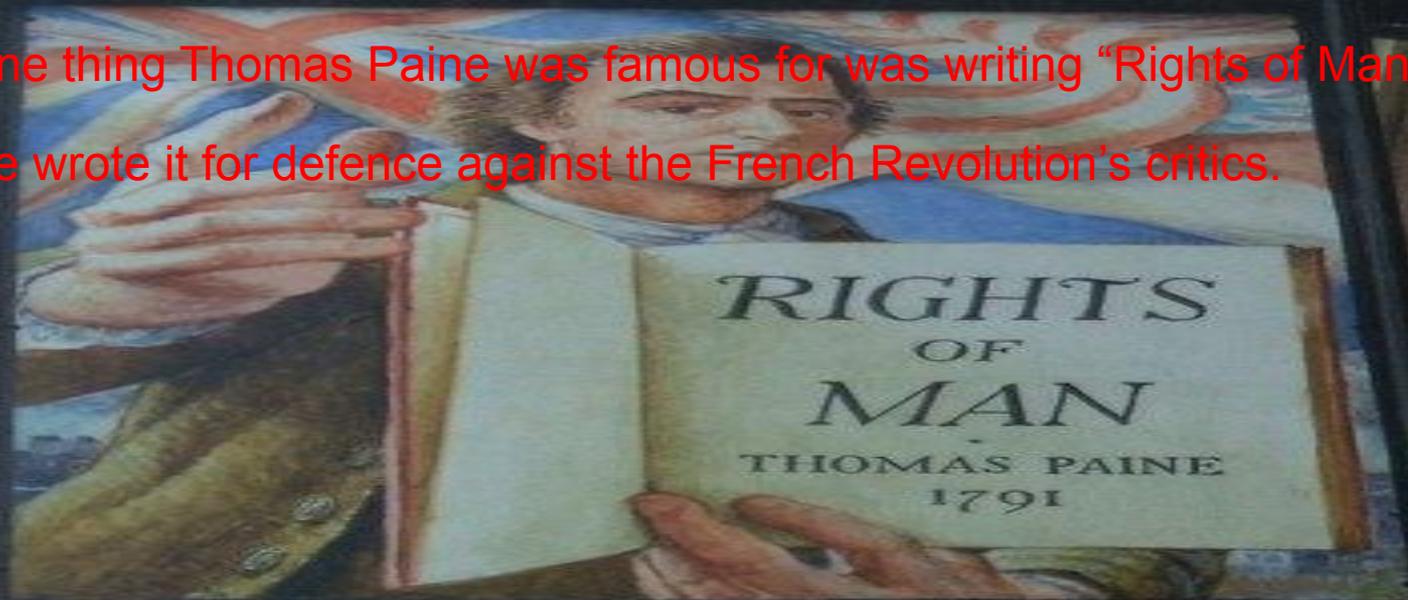
Thomas Paine's Childhood

He wrote it for defence against the French Revolution's critics.

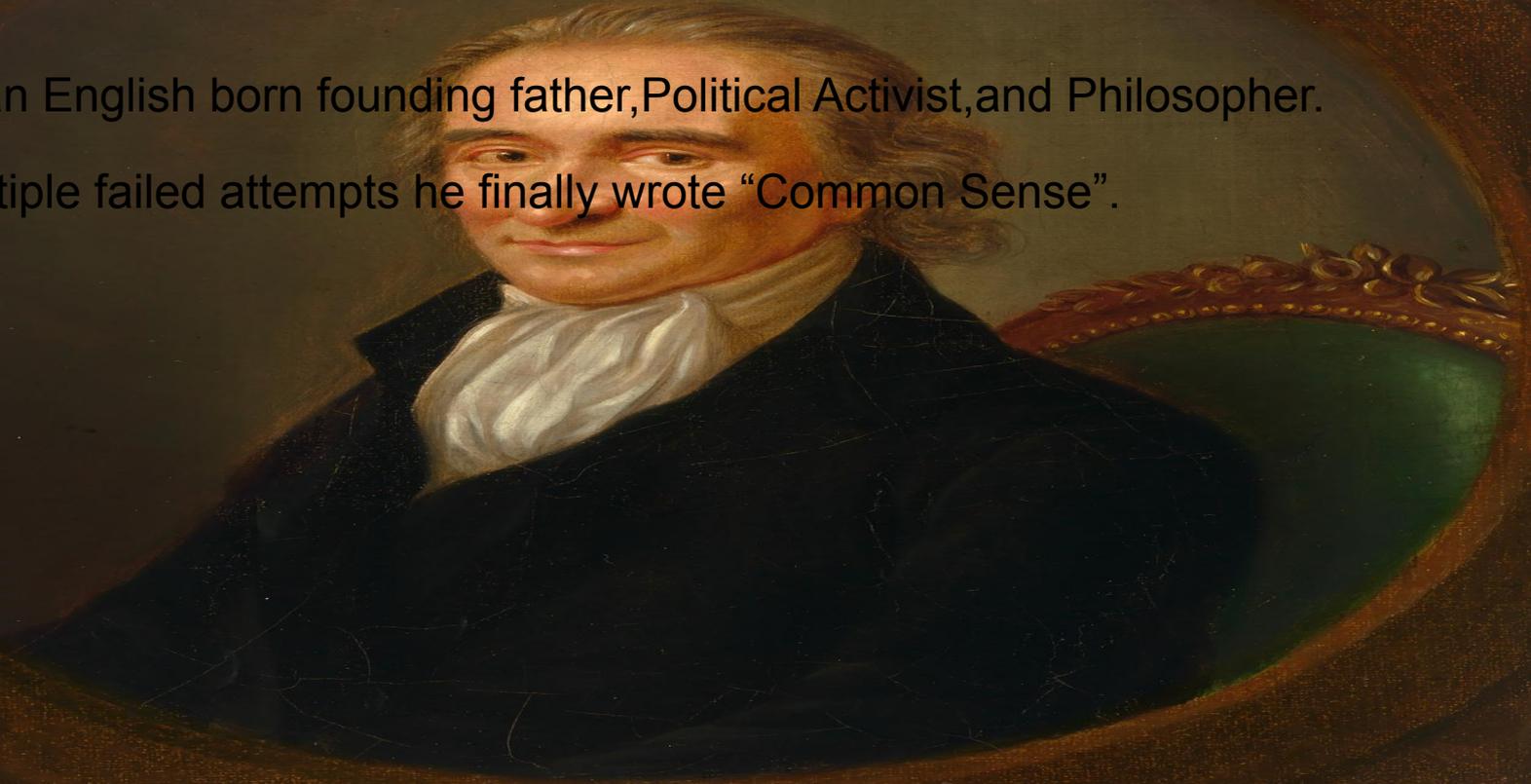
