




# JOHN SMITH





- **Born in Willoughby, United Kingdom around Jan. 6, 1580 (this was his baptism date)**
- **Died June 21, 1631 in London, England**

# Who Is John Smith?

- He was an English soldier, explorer, colonial governor, admiral of New England, author
- Important in helping settle the first colony in America - Jamestown, Virginia
- He led the Jamestown colony from 1608-1609
- He led exploration of the Virginia rivers and the Chesapeake Bay.
- He was the first explorer to map the Chesapeake Bay area.
- He also explored and mapped the New England coast.
