

## **Lord Of The Nutcracker Men**

### **Requirements for presentation**

You will be expected to present an analysis of a character of your choice in the book. This character may be someone you admired or disliked, a side character that didn't get a lot of attention or was one of the main characters. The focus of this presentation is the idea of how the Great War affected everyone and how they interacted with others around them due to the Great War. The requirements for this presentation are:

1. It must be at least 5 minutes long.
2. You must include well thought out answers to questions below.
3. You must have a visual image that best represents your character.
4. You may not use Power Point/computers to present.
5. You must be prepared to know your presentation well enough to make eye contact with the audience throughout the time of presentation. (You may use notecards with the outline of your presentation to help you remember what to talk about.)
6. You must hand in at the time of presentation your answers STAPLED to this paper along with your Rubric with YOUR NAME AND CHARACTER ON RIGHT HAND SIDE OF RUBRIC.
7. If you don't follow instructions, I will deduct points from your presentation.

1. Which character did you pick for your presentation and explain why.
2. Do you admire or dislike your character? Give examples to support your reasons for your admiration or dislike of character.
3. Does this character inspire you be more like them or serve as a bad example to follow. Give examples and reasons for your answer.
4. How does the Great War affect your character give examples for your answer.
5. What was your character like before, during, and after the Great War?

A. Explain why you think that: Did their opinion change? Did they view others differently?

B. Did relationships change?

C. What conflicts arose in their life during the Great War?

D. How did your character handle the war?

E. What do you want to share to the class what you have personally learned from this character: good or bad

6. What did you learn about the Great War from reading this book?

7. Was there anything that surprised you or new insight on the Great War after reading this book?

8. How did this book help you understand World History?

9. Wrap up your presentation by sharing your opinions on:

A. Great War

B. the book

C. your character.
