

Chapter Summary requirements for the American History:

All The Gallant Men, by Don Stratton

You will be required to read this book and write a chapter summary for each chapter you read. This will include the Prologue, all 14 chapters, and ending with the Epilogue. In total there will be 16-chapter summaries you are required to hand in. Each Summary will be worth 13 points for a **total of 208 points!** This will be a MAJOR part of your grade.

*Please plan ahead about when you will read each chapter. You will have four weeks to read this book. It is wise to include time to type out your summaries right after you have completed your reading for the day. That way your summaries will be fresh in your mind and the stress of trying to remember later on will be removed.

Each Summary must:

1. Be typed out and with a title of the chapter number (1 pt each) along with the title given in the book (1 pt each).
2. Have your name at the top right-hand corner of each page (1 pt each).
3. Have TWO paragraphs typed out:
 - a. The first paragraph will consist of what the chapter was about with a few details (5pts each)
 - b. The second paragraph will consist of your opinions, any feelings you had while reading it, what surprised you, anything new that you learned, what you admire or found disappointing. In addition, anything you want to share about that chapter. (5pts each)
4. Be printed off, stapled all together, and turned in at one time.

I am unable to accept any summaries via drop-box, email, or edvance 360. I do not have the time or resources to read each email, download, pull up, print off, organize, staple and then finally sit down and grade them. 😊

DO NOT CONTACT ME the week your summaries are due with printing problems, any issues with the due date, or an excuse to turn them in late. I am giving you enough time to plan ahead.

*Should you have a printer problem, you will know ahead of time because you are printing each chapter as you read them. This will give you plenty of time to let me know in advance about any issues with your printer.

It is YOUR responsibility to contact me in a TIMELY MANNER with any questions or problems you have about this assignment. I am willing to work
