<b>Design</b>	The instrument design is an original idea.	The instrument design is a modification of an uncommonly used idea.	The instrument design is a modification of a commonly used idea.	The instrument design is a replica of a commonly used idea.
<b>Quality</b>	The instrument can be played 5 or more times without needing repairs.	The instrument can be played 2-4 times without needing repairs.	The instrument can be played only once. It must be repaired after each time it is played.	The instrument needs repairs while it is being played.
