


## Registration

Head, Chest, Mix

- Head voice
  - Cricothyroid dominant
  - Pharynx (soft palate) lifted
- Chest voice
  - Thyroarytenoid dominant
  - "If you're belting above the second space, you're just shouting off your face." (Wells, 2018).
- Mix
  - "You can't mix if you don't have a developed head voice." (Pritz, 2015).

### Activity:

*You are judges from the past season of The Voice being interviewed for VoiceLife Magazine. The interviewer wants to know what it is about the registration of the past winner that set her apart from the other contestants.*

### What to do:

1. Find one example of each register in the video. **Identify** the example, & **explain** why it helps create a compelling performance.
2. Leave readers an **overall statement** about what to expect from her career based on her performance.
