

Art Standards for College Project:

I think the above art standards could enhance my AVID 11 College Fair Research Project ([LESSON PLAN](#)). Particularly, I think this standard, *HS Proficient VA:[Cr2.3.1a](#)- Collaboratively develop a proposal for an installation, artwork, or space design that transforms the perception and experience of a particular place*, is very fitting in the AVID curriculum. A major focus in AVID is collaboration, so this standard works to incorporate work on collaboration through art. I could have students work together to create their college project, and create an art aspect to the project, where they need to collaborate with one another to create the art piece. My goal would be to have the students create an art piece of their choice to further represent the college they are researching. This would help the students deepen their understanding of colleges in general and the different characteristics that make up a college (location, climate, acceptance rate, campus life, etc.), which they then can use to help them make a decision about what college they would like to attend next year. This would also allow my students to get exposure to creating art, as some of them were not able to fit an art elective into their schedule. I am excited to see what mode of art my students choose, and how they choose to express themselves and their understanding of the important characteristics of their college and how that makes it stand out among the rest of the colleges they could choose from.
